1. The organizer of the contest is Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, Poland.

2. The co-organizer of the contest is Hieronim Łopaciński Provincial Public Library in Lublin, Poland.

## § 2

- 1. The aim of the competition is:
  - 1) shaping sensitivity to diversity,
  - 2) promoting social inclusion;
  - 3) promoting equality;
  - promoting empathy and respect for other people, regardless of their background, abilities, religious beliefs or any other characteristics that may distinguish them;
  - introducing the achievements of Polish representatives of the world of art, science, culture, politics and social life to Polish and foreign students,
  - 6) promoting reading;
  - 7) igniting imagination;
  - 8) developing creativity;
  - 9) developing critical thinking skills;
  - 10) developing interests and talents in the field of art and literary forms;
  - 11) shaping sensitivity to the written word;
  - 12) developing language skills, reading comprehension and reading interpretation;
  - 13) developing key competences, in particular cultural awareness and expression;
  - 14) educating to values by shaping civic and patriotic attitudes;
  - 15) developing digital competences.

## § 3

- 1. The Contest is addressed to students born between 2004 and 2010.
- 2. Contestants are to send previously unpublished works inspired by the theme of socio-cultural diversity and inclusivity.

The works may be inspired by the life, works, and public activity of specific representatives of the world of science, art, culture, and politics who have dealt with misunderstanding/exclusion in their lives due to their differences.

- 3. The motto of the Contest is a quotation from Tiziano Terzani's *Letters Against the War*: "Only if we manage to see the universe as a single entity, in which every part reflects the whole and whose great beauty lies precisely in its variety, will we be able to understand exactly who and where we are".
- 4. The competition is divided into the following categories:
  - artistic work (drawing, painting, photography) depicting a unique perspective on integration, understanding, acceptance, and the beauty of diversity as well as the inclusion of different environments, cultures, or identities.
  - 2) literary a prose or poetic form on one of the following topics:
  - I. Bring together characters from different time periods and connect them in a common narrative. Show how historical or fictional characters would interact with and learn from each other in a world that values inclusivity.
  - II. Write a story that connects characters from different cultures, environments backgrounds, or worlds. Show the beauty of unity amidst diversity through interactions and relationships between these characters.
  - III. Draw inspiration from a well-known narrative and rewrite it from the perspective of a character who is often overlooked or marginalized. Show how their unique point of view adds depth and richness to the entire story.
  - IV. Share a personal story or reflection about a moment in your life when accepting differences played a significant role. Connect your experiences with the broader topic of inclusivity.
  - V. Build a story around a symbolic object that represents inclusivity. Explore how this item, whether magical or ordinary, has the power to bring people together and bridge the gaps between different individuals.
- 5. One student can choose either the artistic or the literary category
- 6. In the artistic category of the Contest, artworks created using any technique can be submitted. The illustration should be accompanied by a brief description stating the source of inspiration.
- 7. In the literary category:
  - 1) Papers can be written in Polish or English.
  - 2) Students from Polish schools abroad can submit papers written in Polish.
  - The maximum length of text submitted to the competition is two A4 pages, printed in Times New Roman font, size 12, with 1.5 lines spacing.
- 8. The Contest consists of two stages:
  - 1) school stage takes place in the contestant's school: the school jury chooses maximum 5 best works that can be submitted to the next stage,

- 2) international stage where the works submitted will be assessed by the jury appointed by the organizer.
- 9. No collective work is allowed.
- 10. The evaluation of the entries will be conducted by the competition jury appointed by the Organizer. The jury will consist of representatives from Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, Maria Curie- Skłodowska University and the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin. The works will be evaluated by the competition jury appointed by the Organizer.
- 11. The following will be evaluated:
  - 1) accordance of the work with the subject of the contest,
  - 2) artistic value, creativity and originality of the work,
  - 3) stylistic and linguistic accuracy of the literary work.
- 12. The winners of the Contest will in-kind prizes and certificates.
- 13. The Jury reserves the right to award additional prizes and honorable mentions.
- 14. The jury's decisions are final.

## § 4

The school committee sends the chosen entries for the Contest recorded on a CD via traditional mail in a sealed envelope. The envelope should be addressed: **International Art and Literary Contest, VI Liceum Ogólnokształcące im. Hugona Kołłątaja w Lublinie, ul. Mickiewicza 36, 20-466 Lublin, Poland**. Alternatively, entries can be delivered in person to the school's secretary office or sent via email to the address: poczta@lo6.lublin.eu.

- 1. The work submitted should include:
  - 1) in the artistic category: a scan of an illustration in JPG format with a minimum image size of 1920 x 2460 pixels, **along with a brief description of the source of inspiration**,
  - 2) in the literary category: a literary text in pdf, doc or docx format,
  - 3) report from the school stage of the Competition (Attachment 2),
  - 4) Signed documents:
    - a) parental consent for underage students (Attachment 3),
    - b) copyright statement and personal image release consent (Attachment 4),
    - c) information clause (Attachment 5).
- 2. Works sent by mail need to be on a CD. The CD must include the contestant's name and the information about the category of the contest.
- **3.** Works sent by e-mail should be named with the author's surname, the name of the school and the location (e.g. Kowalski Jan, VI LO, Lublin).

- 4. Incomplete entries (for example not containing a signed information clause or any other necessary attachments) and sent after the deadline will not be evaluated.
- 5. For entries sent by mail, the postmark date determines the submission date. For entries submitted via email, the date of receipt in the inbox determines the submission date.

§ 5

- 1. Submission of works to the competition is simultaneously a declaration that the student:
  - is the author of the submitted illustration/text and holds unlimited copyrights to it, and that the submitted illustration/literary work has not been published or awarded in other competitions,
  - 2) accepts the rules of the Contest,
  - 3) agrees to the free use of the submitted works at any time and in any form, for promotional purposes by the organizers, partners, and sponsors of the competition.

## § 6

- 1. Competition schedule:
  - 1) Announcement of the Contest: March 11, 2024,
  - 2) Submission of application forms: by March 31, 2024 (Attachment 1),
  - 3) submission of the works selected by the jury in the school stage (along with the protocol Attachment 2): by **April 30, 2024**,
  - 4) Announcement of the winners: May 13, 2024.
- 2. The contest results will be published on the Organizer's website: www.lo6.lublin.eu.
- 3. The winners will be notified by e-mail.
- 4. Prizes and diplomas will be sent by post to the address of the school attended by the student.

## INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING OF A PARTICIPANT

In accordance with Article 14 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 /EC (Official Journal of the European Union L. 2016.119.1), General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", we inform that:

1. There has been assigned a Data Protection Regulator who can be contacted via email: lo6@iod.lublin.eu or traditional letter sent to the administrator of your personal data.

1) The participant's personal data (name, surname, year of birth, name of school they attend) and underage participant's legal guardian's personal data (name and surname) included in the registration form as well as the participant's picture will be processed for the purpose of conducting and advertising "Add Some Color, Give It Your Voice: Harmony in diversity.

Inclusivity in Art and Literature", hereinafter referred to as the Contest and afterwards for the purpose of archiving it.

2) The participant's and his/her legal guardian's personal data were obtained from the registration form, which had been sent by the coordinating teacher from the participant's school.

3) The basis for data processing is the consent to data processing given in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 GDPR and Article 81 of the Act on copyright and related rights (February, 4, 1994) regarding dissemination of the image in order to promote an event.

4) The consent to processing personal data of the participant (name, surname, year of birth and name of school they attend) is necessary to participate in the contest. The consent to dissemination of the image is voluntary and does not affect participation in the contest. The consent to dissemination of the image can be withdrawn any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of data which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

5) The data will be processed until all activities connected with organizing and promoting the contest are completed or until consent is withdrawn. Personal data will be stored for 5 years for archival purposes.

6) The Educational Office in Lublin can be the recipient of personal data.

7) Personal data will not be subject to automated processing of data based on automated decision making, in particular they will not be subject to profiling.

8) It is ensured that all persons whose personal data is processed have appropriate rights resulting from the GDPR. Therefore, you have:

a) the right to access your personal data;

b) the right to request correction (revision) of your personal data;

c) the right to request the deletion of your personal data in the cases determined in art.17GDPR;

d) the right to restrict personal data in the cases determined in art.18 GDPR;

e) the right to withdraw your consent to processing your personal data;

f) the right to transfer your personal data in the cases determined in art. 20 GDPR;
