INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

In accordance with Article 14 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (Official Journal of the European Union L 119/1) - General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", we inform that:

1. The administrator of your personal data in connection with organising the International Photographic and Ecological Contest 'Biodiversity and Aquatic Ecosystems Conservation' is Hugo Kołtątaj High School No. 6 in Lublin, ul. Mickiewicza 36, 20-466 Lublin, Poland.
2. There has been assigned a Data Protection Regulator who can be contacted via email: lo6@iod.lublin.eu or traditional letter sent to the administrator of your personal data.
3. The participant's personal data (name, surname, year of birth, name of the school they attend) and the underage participant's legal guardian's personal data (name and surname) included in the registration form, as well as the participant's image will be processed for the purpose of conducting and advertising the International Photographic and Ecological Contest 'Biodiversity and Aquatic Ecosystems Conservation', hereinafter referred to as the contest, and afterwards for the purpose of archiving it.
4. The participant's and his/her legal guardian's personal data were obtained from the registration form, which had been sent by the coordinating teacher from the participant's school.
5. The basis for data processing is the consent to data processing given in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 GDPR and Article 81 of the Act on copyright and related rights (4 February 1994) regarding dissemination of the image in order to promote an event, as well as with the Consistent Itemised File List of Educational Institutions in Lublin, being Attachment 2 to Ordinance 75/4/2017 of 19 April 2017 issued by Mayor of Lublin on „implementing office and archival standards in educational institutions in Lublin” in terms of archival obligation.
6. The consent to processing the participant's personal data (name, surname, year of birth and name of the school they attend) is necessary to take part in the contest. The consent to dissemination of the image is voluntary and does not affect the possibility to participate in the contest. The above-mentioned consents can be withdrawn any time. A withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing data which was made on the basis of the consent before its withdrawal.
7. The data will be processed until all activities connected with organising and promoting the contest are completed or until consent is withdrawn. Personal data will be stored for 5 years for archival purposes.
8. The Educational Office in Lublin can be the recipient of personal data.
9. Personal data will not be subject to automated processing of data based on automated decision making, in particular they will not be subject to profiling.
10. It is ensured that all persons whose personal data is processed have appropriate rights resulting from GDPR. Therefore, you are entitled to:

- a) access your personal data,
- b) demand the correction/revision of your personal data,
- c) demand the deletion of your personal data in the cases determined in Article 17 GDPR,
- d) demand the restriction of processing your personal data in the cases determined in Article 18 GDPR,
- e) withdraw the consent to processing your personal data,
- f) transfer your personal data in the cases determined in Article 20 GDPR,
- g) lodge a complaint to the President of Data Protection Office if you consider processing your data unlawful.
